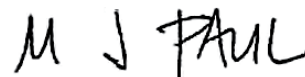

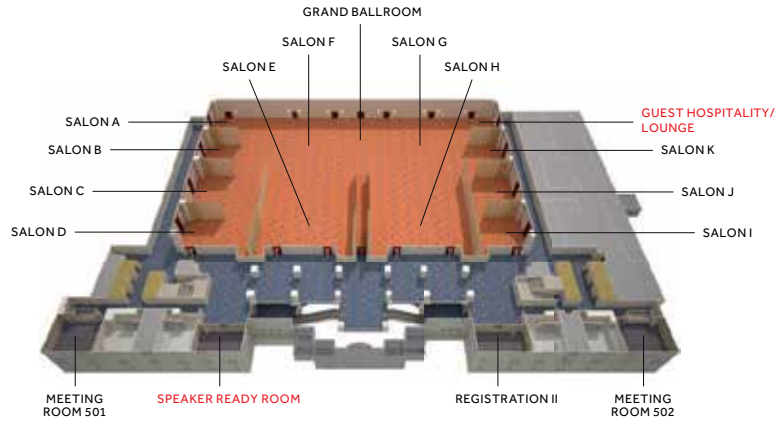

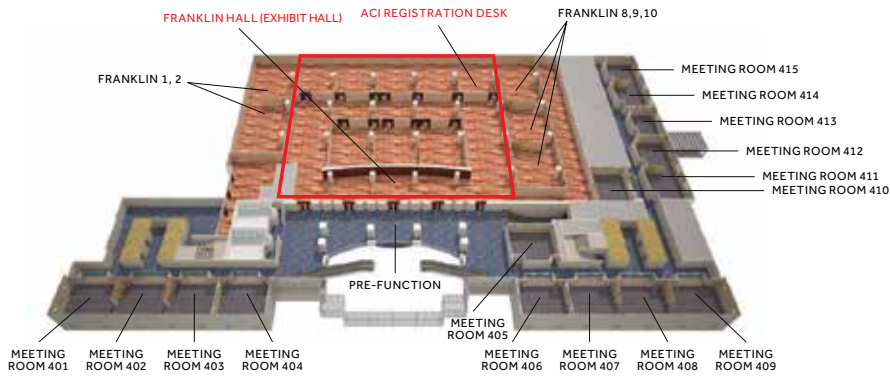
# Meeting Space Map

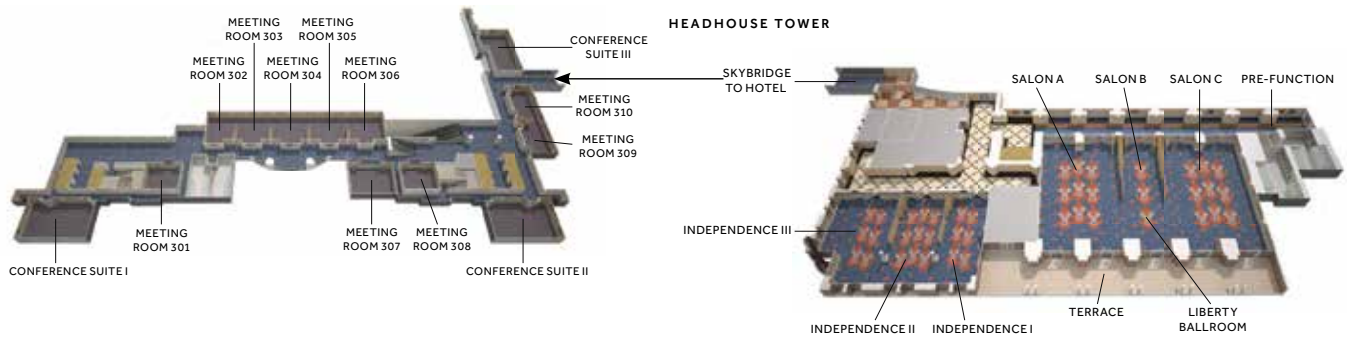

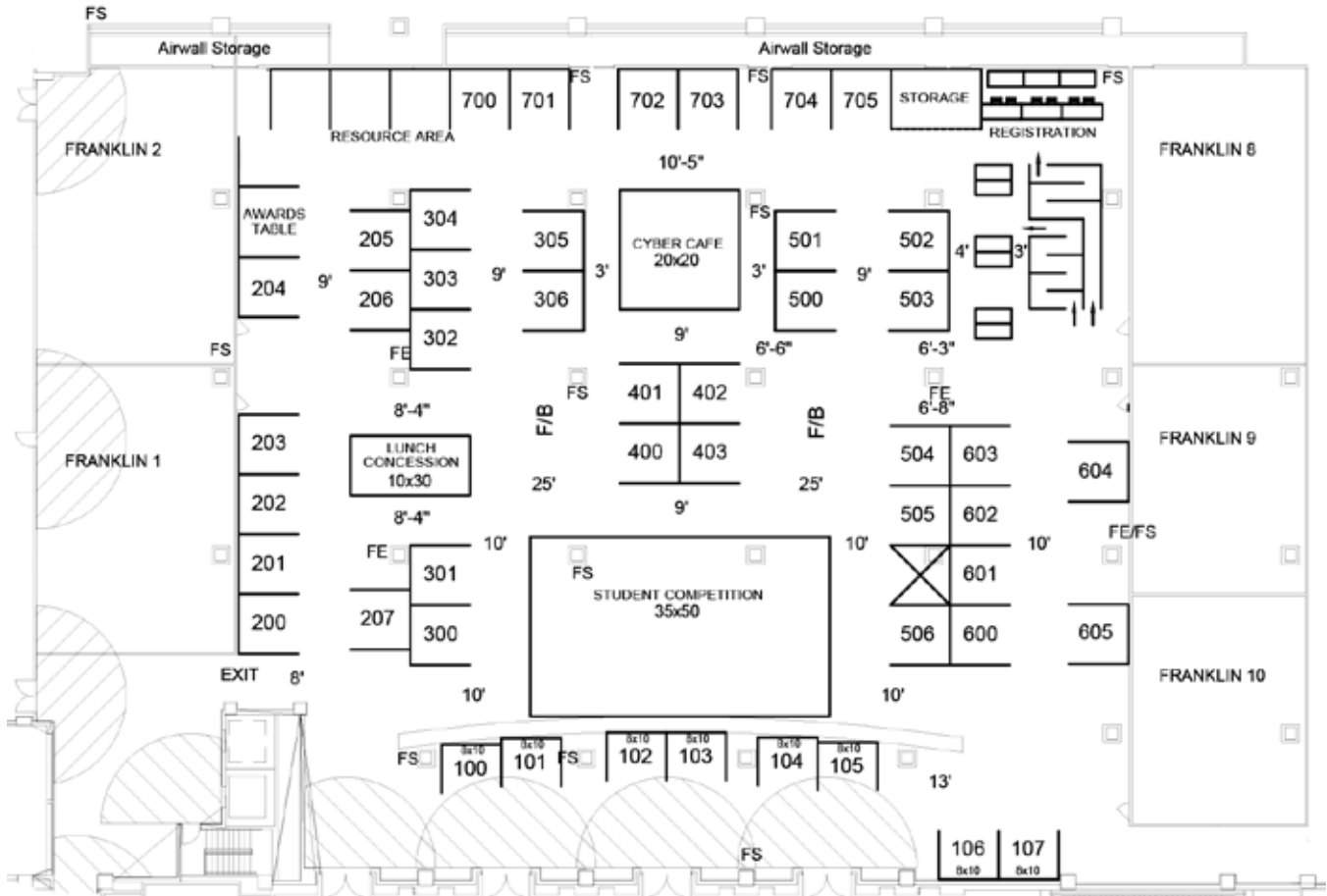


Exhibit Hall Floor Plan
