

Powerpoint – How Many Slides?


- The 5/5/5 rule 5 words per line, 5 lines per page, 5 slides
- The 10/20/30 rule 10 slides in 20 minutes with 30 size font
- The Engineer's Rule Length (minutes) * λ * β * K (it depends..)
 - $\lambda = 1.0$ (easy subject), 0.5 (hard subject), 0.25 (you can't explain the subject)
 - $\beta = 0.5$ (wide awake), **1.0** (somewhat fatigued), **2.0** (sleepy)
 - K = 0.5 (no graphics), **1.0** (some graphics), **2.0** (pictures only)
- The Lawyer's Rule Length (minutes) * β * Σ (it doesn't matter)
- The Hover Rule One of the great mysteries of ACI....
